

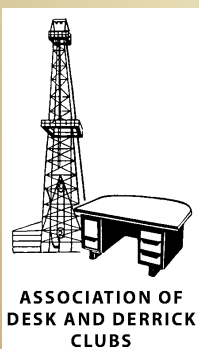
Keep your feet on the ground and keep reaching for the stars, keeping your eye on the brightest start of all during this holiday season, as you travel the routes of energy.
